

BEACH TREASURE HUNT

For the intrepid beachcomber, dead sand dollars, shells, starfish, driftwood and varied smooth stones are not all you'll find. You may also find live critters.



To the right is a live sand dollar. You can tell it's alive because instead of the pale gray or white of a dead sand dollar as seen above, it is a dark gray. Also, on a live sand dollar there are tiny, velvety, hair-like spines that move against your hand. If these are present, place them back in the ocean. The same is true of any live creature. Place them back in the ocean; they are not easy to keep alive outside of their natural environ-



ment. There's nothing quite so therapeutic as taking a walk on the beach. If walking along the beach listening to the waves crash, while smelling the salty ocean air is not

enough for you, then the seven miles of beaches are filled with all sorts of treasures, if you know what you're looking for. To the left are the "spoils" from a walk on the beach. There are

brown, green, white and pale blue sea glass, sand dollars, small rocks, a shell, driftwood and a good-sized piece of white, sea ceramic.



Besides dune grass, which you should never disturb, the most prevalent plant/flower at the ocean is the sea



rose or as its also called, the beach rose. The sea rose was originally from "away", but easily took hold in New England due to its ability to withstand salt spray.

BEACH RULES

- Drinking in public is illegal in the State of Maine including public beaches.
- Lock your car doors and don't leave valuables in the open.
- When on the beach or in open areas don't leave valuables unattended.
- The Old Orchard Beach Town dog park is located in Memorial Park on First Street, across from the Chamber of Commerce and Train Station.
- From May 15th to Labor Day dogs are not allowed on the beach from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm and dogs on a leash from 5:00 pm to dusk.
- Sand dunes and grass are protected under Maine state law.
- · Fireworks, open flames, fires, grills, and charcoal are prohibited on all town beaches.

- Horses and horseback riding are allowed only from October 1 through March 31. Riders must obtain a permit from the Town Clerks office at Scarborough Town Hall or Old Orchard Beach Town Hall.





THE OLD ORCHARD BEACH PIER





Exciting news for Old Orchard Beach
- The Pier will be celebrating its 125th anniversary in 2023!
The Old Orchard Beach Pier has undergone many changes since its

conception, but it has remained a popular entertainment spot for over a century. The 1825-foot structure, built with three pavilions by the Berlin Iron Bridge Company for \$38,000, first opened to the public on July 2, 1898. However, the start of a long and historic battle between man's entertainment spot and nature began shortly after, as the Pier and Casino were partially damaged by a storm in November of the same year and had to be rebuilt in 1899.

Like the ebb and flow of the tides in Maine, time and preferences have come and gone. The structure of the Pier has endured damage from nature, and people have



responded in kind by rebuilding and protecting traditions. Tourists have been moved by the rhythm of the ocean and music. Talented entertainers played while people responded in many versions of dances.

As mentioned earlier, the Pier has experienced many setbacks starting in the first year. The second setback happened in August of 1907 when a fire destroyed the entrance. Once again, the pier was rebuilt in 1908. The following year, in 1909, the pavilions were swept away by a great storm in March. This storm caused extensive damage, and the casino was shortened from its original length of 1,825 feet to 1,000 feet. Sixty years later, in 1969, a fire destroyed most of the structure. A series of storms ebbed



away at the pier, causing the casino to be razed in 1970. Then, the great blizzard of 1978 destroyed what was left of the pier. The

Pier was rebuilt by the Golzbein family to what we know it to be today and reopened in 1980.

100 years earlier in 1880, a local entrepreneur named Nathan Woolf opened a gift shop at the Old Orchard Beach train station, selling souvenirs. He later had the foresight to move his business



to the Pier and in 1898 established Woolf's Souvenir Gift Shop, becoming a part of the Pier's rich history. An

interesting story, Nathan Woolf is the

great-grandfather of the current owner

of the Pier, Paul Golzbein. Nathan Woolf's

family has maintained a presence on the



Pier for four generations. One decision with a ripple effect that saved the Pier from ruin.

From its inception, the Pier was known as an entertainment venue hosting a wide array of entertainment including concerts,

dancing, and lectures, as well as a casino located at the very end of the pier. During the mid-20th century, the Pier's Casino Ballroom was in its heyday and held as many as 5,000 people for a single event. The Ballroom was noted for its moving picture shows and live entertainment, featuring acts such as Frank Sinatra, Xavier Cugat, Louis "Satchmo" Armstrong, and Benny Goodman. Celebrities and dignitaries alike made this one of the premier spots to visit on the East Coast. Today, Pier's reputation for great entertainment and food continues the rich tradition of great entertainers and an all-around fun experience that keeps it as relevant today as it has been for the past 125 years.

Protecting the very essence of Old Orchard Beach, the iconic Pier takes a lot of hard work and dedication. The Golzbein family has taken this task as a family mission and has made every effort to protect this iconic structure. If asked why, their response continues to be "It's in our blood."






